## **VENUE**

Venue Championship is 220 km north of the city of Astana, in the resort area Burabay, which before were called "Kazakh Switzerland". Nestled among boundless steppes of Kazakhstan, Burabay resort is attractive for its clean air, beautiful lakes surrounded by mountain ranges with a dense pine forest.

## **TRANSPORTATION TO THE VENUE**

Point of arrival for participants and guests is Astana International Airport. Venue Championship is located 220 km from the city of Astana. Organizers provide transfer to the venue and back to the airport for the participants on request. The one way fare is 30 Euro.

## **ACCOMMODATION**

Accommodation will be arranged in the hotel complex "Bereke-Burabay", located in the national nature park Burabay. Hotel complex "Bereke-Burabay" is the largest and modern in Burabay. By the request of some countries will be provided the possibility of placing elsewhere

## **WEATHER**

The weather at this time of the year is stable, sunny, with daily temperatures 12-18 degrees Celsius. In September occasional rain is possible.

## **SHOWGROUND**

District competitions are close to the placement of participants at a distance of about 20-30 minutes away by bus. The grounds of the competition, is a mostly forest, located at an altitude of 400-600 meters above sea level.

## **VISA REQUIREMENTS**

For participants and guests of the Championship visa support will be provided by Kazakhstan. Information about visa support will be provided after receiving application of participation in the Championship.

**8 September, *Monday*** – First classic competition, awarding;

**9 September, *Tuesday*** – Cultural event, Working Group meeting;

**10 September, *Wednesday*** – Second classic competition, awarding, arrival for Sprint and Foxoring;

**11 September, *Thursday*** – Training for Sprint and Foxoring competitions, in the afternoon Sprint competition\*, awarding\*\*;

**12 September, *Friday*** – Foxoring competition\*, awarding\*\*, Closing ceremony and banquet;

**13 September, *Saturday*** – Departure

## ENTRY FEE AND TERMS OF PAYMENT

There are a few options depending on the status of the participants, needs of accommodation/full board, and date of payment as follows:

**a) Participation fee (for competitors and Team officials only)** – Euro 40 per competition day;

**b) Full package for competitors and Team officials:**

**6-13 September** - Euro 490 if paid till 30 June or Euro 540 if paid after 30 June, includes participation fee for Classic, Sprint and Foxoring competitions accommodation, transportation to the start and from the finish, maps, and banquet;

**6-11 September** – Euro 410 if paid till 30 June or Euro 450 if paid after 30 June (includes), includes participation fee for classic competitions, accommodation, transportation to the start and from the finish, and maps;

**10-13 September** - Euro 330 if paid till 30 June or Euro 360 if paid after 30 June, includes participation fee for Sprint and Foxoring competitions, accommodation, transportation to the start and from the finish, maps, and banquet;

**c) Full package for guests/visitors (out of participants and Team officials):**

**6-13 September** Euro 330 if paid till 30 June or Euro 380 if paid after 30 June, includes accommodation, transportation to the start and from the finish, and banquet.

**6-11 September** Euro 330 if paid till 30 June or Euro 370 if paid after 30 June, includes accommodation and transportation to the start and from the finish.

**10-13 September** Euro 250 if paid till 30 June or Euro 280 if paid after 30 June, includes accommodation, transportation to the start and from the finish, and banquet.
